



### **CCRC provides hazardous waste collection in Claremore**

CATOOSA, Okla. — Cherokee CRC recently worked with the city of Claremore on a public household hazardous waste collection event.

This event was free to Claremore residents and provided them with an opportunity to properly dispose of common household pollutants. The items collected included E-wastes, such as computers, monitors, televisions and other small electronic devices as well as 191 used tires, 331 pounds of aerosols, 125 car batteries, 272 feet of fluorescent bulbs, 700 pounds of hazardous cleaners, 1,983 pounds of flammable liquids, 3,447 pounds of used motor oil and gear lube, 3,205 pounds of latex paint and 549 pounds of pesticides.

Proper disposal of these items is essential to protect the environment and prevent the contamination of natural resources.

The event was a great success and Cherokee CRC was proud to help Claremore protect the environment by properly disposing of household hazardous waste.

This was the second time CCRC has provided this service for Claremore. In 2010 CCRC also provided a household hazardous waste event to the city. That event also was a great success. CCRC hopes to build upon its relationship with Claremore by continuing to provide this service in the future.
